



Shelby Cattle Co. Dispersal

Sale Report

The Shelby Cattle Co. Dispersal of Black and Red Angus genetics was held on September 8th, 2018 at the Tennessee Livestock Center in Columbia, TN. There was a standing-room only crowd on hand along with buyers on the internet and on the phones for the maternally efficient cattle managed on fescue.

Black Angus Highlights:

The high-selling Lot was Senior Herd Sire OCC Unlimited 940U. The 10/25/08 son of OCC Linebred 661L was selected by Sanford Ranches, Greenwood, TX at \$15,000.00.

The top-selling heifer calf pair was Lot 68/68A. Baron Buzhardt selected both the cow and heifer calf. The cow is a 4/3/08 daughter of OCC Eureka 865E bred back to OCC Unlimited 940U and brought \$5,750.00. Her heifer calf is a 1/30/18 daughter of OCC Unlimited 940U and commanded a bid of \$3,900.00 to bring the value of the pair to \$9,650.00.

Another top pair was Lot 21/21A. The cow is a 1/24/09 daughter of OCC Piqua 732P bred back to OCC Unlimited 940U and was selected by James Maguire, Wyndmoor, PA at \$3,750.00. Her heifer calf, a 2/3/18 daughter of OCC Unlimited 940U was selected by Luke Lichtenwalner, Emmaus, PA at \$2,500.00 to bring the value of the pair to \$6,250.00.

Bull calf pairs were in great demand. Lot 78/78A lead the pack with a 3/6/08 daughter of OCC Prestige 672P, bred back to OCC Unlimited 940U, and chosen by George Gersema, Boise, ID at \$5,750.00. Gersema also selected her 2/14/18 son of OCC Unlimited 940U at \$1,700.00 to bring the pair to value \$7,450.00.

Lot 10A/10B was another popular pair. The cow, a 2/26/14 daughter of Cole Creek Cedar Ridge 82, bred back to OCC Unlimited 940U, was selected by Derek Giffin, Union City, TN at \$4,750.00. Dirk Johnson of Tetonia, ID selected her 2/28/18 son of OCC Unlimited 940U at \$1,800.00 to bring the pair's value to \$6,550.00.

Fall and early Spring bred cows were highly sought after. Lot 7, a 9/13/11 daughter by OCC Rear End 751R and heavy bred to OCC Unlimited 940U sold to Jon Williams, Union Grove, AL at \$5,500.00. Another top seller at \$5,500.00 was Lot 23, a 9/23/11 daughter of OCC Rear End 751R, also heavy bred to OCC Unlimited 940U and purchased by Trendsetter Genetics, Glencoe, OK. Paul Woodham, Headland, AL selected two top cows. The first was Lot 31, a 9/19/15 daughter of OCC Homer 650H, heavy bred to SCC 780D, bringing \$5,250.00. Woodam also took Lot 30, a 9/19/13 daughter of Sinclair Timeless 8BF4, heavy bred to SCC 723C at \$5,000.00.

Several heifers topped the Bred Heifer Division at \$4,000.00. Lot 11B, a 9/25/16 daughter of SCC Practical 06Z bred to SCC 794D was chosen by Dan Glenn, Fitzgerald, GA. Another was Lot 42B, a daughter of OCC Unlimited 940U safe to SCC 795D, selected by Richard Simmons, Mason, TN. James Maguire, Wyndmoor, PA took two bred heifers at \$4,000.00. He selected Lot 30B, a 10/8/16 daughter of SCC 968A safe to SCC 794D and Lot 89, a daughter of OCC Unlimited 940U safe to SCC 795D.

Yearling Open Heifers found many fans. George Gersema, Boise, ID took two outstanding heifers. Lot 50A, a 10/14/17 daughter of SCC 632B at \$3,200.00 and Lot 22A, a 10/26/17 daughter of SCC 632B at \$3,100.00.

A special Sale feature was Lot 26. She sold with her 8/18/18 herd sire prospect by OCC Unlimited 940U. She is a 9/19/11 daughter of OCC Rear End 751R and was purchased by Jon Williams, Union Grove, AL at \$7,500.00.

Red Angus Highlights:

The featured Senior Herd Sire, Red Hill 84S Julian 217C, was the top-selling Lot 304 in the Red division. He is a 9/5/15 son of Red Hill B571 Julian 84S, and was selected by Mark Gunther, Muddy Pond, TN at \$11,500.00.

Heifer calf pair splits were in strong demand. Lot 208/208A topped the division. The cow, an 8/17/11 daughter by Red Hill B571 Julian 84S bred to Red Hill 84S Julian 217C sold to Dan Glenn, Fitzgerald, GA at \$2,900.00. Genn also took her 2/13/18 heifer calf by RHF-Buf T189 Medal 175C at \$2,100.00 bringing the pair value to \$5,000.00. Another exceptional heifer pair was Lot 215/215A. The cow is a 5/1/05 daughter of Beckton Epic KJ J722 and is safe to Red Hill 84S Julian 217C. She was selected by Terry Holdeman, Halstead, KS at \$2,100.00. Her heifer calf, a 3/8/18 daughter by Red Hill 84S Julian 217C was purchased by Joshua Ballard, Shelbyville, KY at \$2,000.00 to bring the pair value to \$4,100.00.

The top-selling bull calf pair was 202C/202D. The cow is a 1/11/16 daughter of OH 84S 294Z ,safe to Red Hill 84S Julian 217C, and was chosen by Steve Chambers, Selina, TX at \$3,300.00. Her 2/11/18 herd sire prospect by Red Hill 84S Julian 217C sold at \$1,100.00 to Allen Waddell, Emelle, AL. Another excellent pair was Lot 202/202A. The cow is a 1/14/14 daughter of Gourley Cruz 1103, safe to Red Hill 84S Julian 217C, selected by Steve Chambers, Selina, TX at \$2,700.00. Her calf, a 2/14/18 son of Red Hill 84S Julian 217C sold to Joseph Saxon, Godsden, AL at \$1,200.00 to bring the pair to a \$3,900.00 value.
