



## **4<sup>th</sup> Annual Oliver Angus Sale Sale Report October 2, 2018**

Cattle met great demand again this year. The offering was comprised of weanling heifer calves, weanling herd bull prospects, bred cows and a senior herd bull. The tele-auction format included bidders and buyers from AL, GA, TX, OK, PA, ND, SD, KY, NC and VA.

The weanling heifers were the best-ever sold to date and commanded active bidding. Leading the group was Lot 2, a 12/29/17 daughter of Mr Spen 128 147 330. She was selected by Erika Cotton, Volga, SD at \$2,700.00. Lot 8 was also a popular heifer. She is a 1/11/18 daughter of Mr Spen 128 147 330 and was chosen by Tudor Oak Farm, Asheboro, NC at \$2,500.00

The herd sire prospects are thick and stout and found many repeat buyers, as well as, new bidders this year. Top-seller was Lot 24, a 1/6/18 son of O Mr 120 147 410. He was purchased by Brent Stepp, Calhoun, GA at \$3,100.00. Another top-selling bull was Lot 20, a 1/1/18 son of Mr Spen 128 147 330 and was selected by Gene Warzecha, Harvey, ND at \$2,400.00.

The bred cows were in strong demand from buyers all over the country. Lot 38, a 9/28/09 daughter of TSF Time Traveler T22, bred to O Mr 120 147 410. She will become an important part of the herd at Tudor Oak Farms, Asheboro, NC and sold at \$3,400.00. The second top-selling cow was Lot 37, a 10/29/09 daughter of O Mr Casey 41-97, safe in calf to O Mr 120 147 410. She sold at \$3,000.00 and will enter the Donor pen at Goddard Farms, Wilkesboro, NC.

The Lot 1 proven Herd Sire, a 1/15/16 son of the matriarch O Miss Alap L 2246-41. He was chosen by Rasco Angus, Jemison, AL at \$2,900.00.
